This activity aims to;

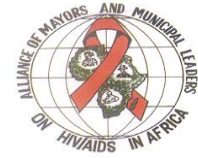

- Objective 1: To assess achievement of objectives of the HIV prevention program for Key Populations
  - Evaluate performance of the HIV prevention program
  - Identify barriers for reaching HIV prevention goals
  - Document best practices
  - Identify relevance of the program design and document recommendations
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- Objective 2: To assess the achievement of objectives for the treatment and support intervention for People Living with HIV (PLHIV)
  - Conduct performance evaluation of the PLHIV program using electronic database
  - Identify barriers for reaching goal
  - Engage with beneficiaries to identify relevance and improvement of the program
  - Document best practices
